

Hands-On Safety At Sea Seminar SUNY Maritime, Sat., April 14th



The Storm Trysail Foundation along with SUNY Maritime and the US Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point will be conducting a Safety At Sea Seminar that will stress hands-on education.

Part of the day will be spent on the water doing man overboard recovery drills as well as setting storm sails and reefing. Participants will fire flares and fight fires. While there will be classroom sessions, the focus will be hands on training. You will not end up falling asleep in a bad banquet room chairs. This seminar meets the requirements for a US Sailing SAS certificate of attendance, which is good for five years.

The cost is \$200 per person. Lunch is included and any proceeds will be shared between the Storm Trysail Foundation and the sailing programs of SUNY and Kings Point. Additional contributions are welcomed.
